SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Dear High School Guidance Counselor:

AAA Michigan is pleased to announce the 17th annual AAA School Safety Patrol Scholarship Program.

Scholarships of \$1,000 will again be awarded to two graduating seniors attending a Michigan public, private or charter high school. Students must show documented proof of AAA Michigan School Safety Patrol participation in elementary or middle school, good academic standing and a strong record of involvement in the community and/or extra curricular activities. A personal letter of introduction must be included describing community and extra-curricular activities and what being a Safety Patroller meant to them.

Enclosed are 10 applications for you to make available to qualified students in your school. Photocopies are accepted. Please review the guidelines and requirements to assist your students in the application process. We ask that the guidance counselor and school faculty and administration assist with the initial screening. Please be aware that AAA Michigan will accept only one applicant per school. **Please be sure that the Principal or Counselor signs the application selected. Applications lacking this signature cannot be processed.** The deadline for submission of your schools' applicant is April 13, 2012.
